

Master's in Hotel Administration (HOA) Degree Program Course Overview for Incoming Fall 2024 Recruits

The HOA program has been revised for all students entering Fall 2024 and forward. Below are the options for completing the revised 24-credit Dual Master's in Hotel Administration (HOA)/Master's Information Systems degree program.

Thesis Track: Students will take 3-credits of thesis in the fall and spring term in the second year for a total of 6 credits. Students cannot take all 6 credits in one semester. If you choose to change your track, you must do so before the end of the Spring Semester and secure a Thesis Chair.
