

Master's in Hotel Administration (HOA) Degree Program

Course Overview for Incoming Fall Recruits

Below are the options for completing the revised 31-credit Master's in Hotel Administration (HOA) degree program. The Dual program outlines are on page 3 & 4 along with the electives on the final page.

NOTE: Core courses must be completed as outlined below. Students cannot complete just one core course. Each core is an 8-week session and are taught the first 8 weeks and second 8 weeks of a semester. Example: In Fall the core courses are taught on-campus once a week, starting with HOA 701 and HOA 734 for the first 8-weeks, HOA and then HOA 745 for the last 8-weeks.

Thesis Track: you will take 3 thesis credits in your last two semesters for a total of 6 credits over two semesters. If you choose to change your track, you must do so before the end of the Spring Semester, otherwise, you will need to secure a Thesis Chair.
